

**Final Environmental Assessment for
Basing F-15EX Eagle II First Operational Combat
Squadron at Portland Air National Guard Installation,
Portland, Oregon**

The Department of the Air Force (DAF) announces the availability of the Final Environmental Assessment (EA) and Finding of No Significant Impact (FONSI) for the proposed basing of the F-15EX Eagle II Operational Combat Squadron at Portland Air National Guard (ANG) installation, Portland, Oregon. The DAF has prepared a Final EA to analyze the potential impacts of recapitalizing its existing F-15C inventory at Portland ANG installation with the newer and more capable F-15EX aircraft. Recapitalization is the acquisition of the new generation F-15EX aircraft and construction and upgrade of specific facilities for one squadron of F-15EX aircraft to support current and future combat and mission readiness. The squadron would consist of up to 24 F-15EX aircraft that would replace the existing 20 F-15C aircraft currently based at the installation.
