MyAirForceBenefits Executive Summary

- **MyAirForceBenefits is the Air Force's response to the 2006 and 2010 NDAA's**, which prescribe a readily accessible, web-based, public-facing benefit information site for Airmen, (Active, Guard, and Reserve) Family members, retired Airmen, Survivors and the general public
- **MyAirForceBenefits is accessible via .mil and public networks and provides:**
 - Approximately 500,000 Airmen across all components and their family members full access to benefits information related to military service
 - Survivors with tailored casualty benefits information validated via the Airman and Family Readiness Survivor Benefits Office
- **Bottom line:** MyAirForceBenefits arms Commanders, Benefits Counselors, Airmen and their families with personalized benefits information to facilitate financially-based decision-making

MyAirForceBenefits Functionality

- **Survivor Benefits Calculator:** provides a personalized report projecting the lifetime stream of survivor benefits, which is essential for Airmen to help prepare their families for financial readiness in the event of their death on active duty or inactive duty for training
- **Retirement System Calculator:** provides Airmen with a personalized calculation of their projected retired pay and facilitates an interactive “what if” capability to support effective retirement planning
- **Survivor Benefit Plan (SBP) Premium Calculator:** allows Airmen to determine SBP premium costs for different beneficiary options at retirement, as well as the ability to adjust base amount and see modified premiums
- **Deployment Calculator:** enables Airmen and their families to understand and prepare for the changes that occur in pay and allowances prior to and during deployments
- **Casualty Operations Module:** provides surviving family members with validated initial Survivor Benefit Reports, to include a calculator for surviving spouses to see their family’s updated lifetime stream of benefits and to conduct “what-if” calculations
- **Benefits Library:** contains Federal and State/Territory Benefits fact sheets and a Resource Locator; fact sheets are updated annually or more often as needed
- **MyAirForceBenefits Help Desk:** provides personalized assessments, support and reports for service and family members, and is accessible through the MAFB website, email, and/or phone

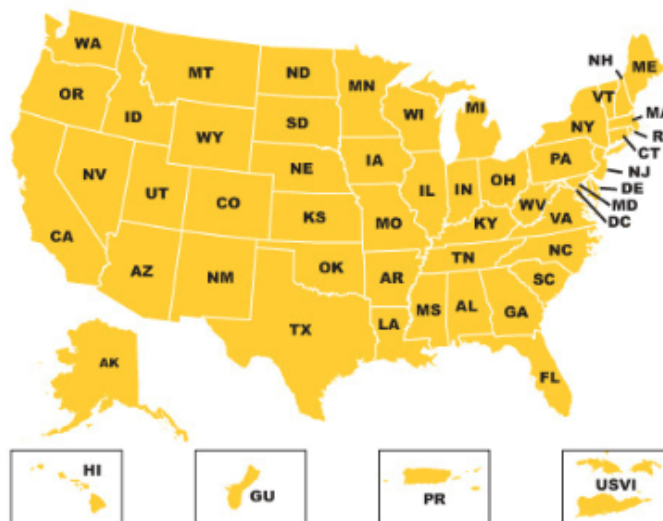

What are my Maryland State Tax Benefits?

Maryland Income Tax on Retired Military Pay: Military retirees or the Spouse of military retiree can subtract up to \$5,000 with an increase to the first \$15,000 for individuals who are at least 55 years old on the last day of the taxable year, of your military retirement income from your federal adjusted gross income before determining your Maryland tax.

Who is eligible for a reduction in Maryland Income Tax on Retired Military Pay? The retirement income must have been received as a result of any of the following military service:

- ★ Induction into the U.S. armed forces for training and service under the Selective Training and Service Act of 1940 or a subsequent Act of similar nature.
- ★ Membership in a reserve component of the U.S. armed forces.
- ★ Membership in an active component of the U.S. armed forces.
- ★ Membership in the Maryland National Guard.



The benefit also applies to persons separated from active duty employment with the commissioned corps of the Public Health Service, the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration, or the Coast and Geodetic Survey.

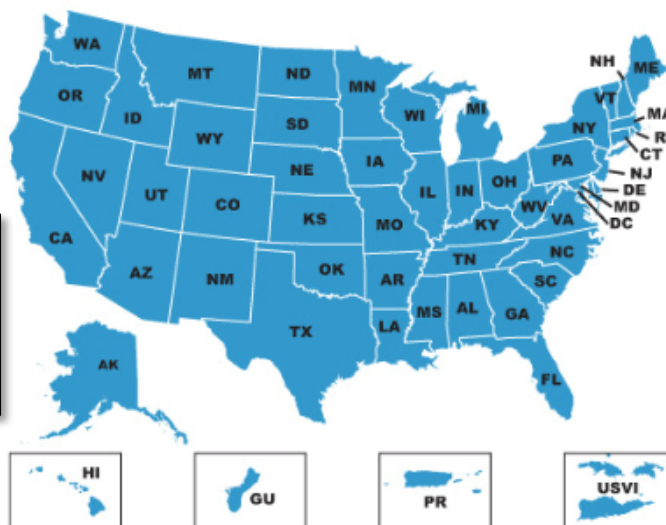

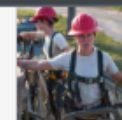

That formula is: 2.5% of the first \$869 of the selected Base Amount, plus 10% of the remaining Base Amount. The crossover point at which premiums are lower at 6.5% is \$1,862, i.e. for Base Amounts of \$1,861 or more, the premium is simply 6.5% of the Base Amount.
- Retirees are recommended to notify DFAS as soon as possible when a beneficiary change occurs. Events like divorce, remarriage, or the birth of a child can affect SBP premiums.



Fry Scholarship ?

Surviving Spouses and Children of Service members who died on active duty after 9/10/2001 may also be entitled to a Fry Scholarship from VA. Fry Scholarships may pay up to full tuition for an in-state public school or up to the National Maximum for private or foreign schools, plus a monthly living stipend and book allowance, for 36 months. Surviving Spouses of Service members who died on active duty after 9/10/2001 and surviving Children of Service members who died on active duty on or after 8/1/2011 must irrevocably elect to receive benefits under either Fry or DEA; they cannot use both. Surviving Children of Service members who died between 9/10/2001 and 8/1/2011 may be eligible for both DEA and Fry, consecutively, but not concurrently, for a combined total of up to 81 months. Surviving Children who become eligible for 36 months of benefits under the Post-9/11 GI Bill based upon their own military service retain eligibility for both DEA and Fry, as well as their own Post-9/11 GI Bill benefits, for a total of up to 81 months of education benefits.
